

## **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES**

1. Candidates shall be required to download their respective Admit Cards by logging into their account in <admission.spab.ac.in> and paste a self attested stamp size recent photograph in the space provided for in the Admit Card. Admit card can be downloaded from **June 11, 2018 from 4 p.m.** onwards.
2. No candidate shall be allowed to appear for the written test and interview without the valid Admit Card.
3. Candidates must carry black ball point pen with him / her. No student will be allowed to write the answer either in pencil or ink pen.
4. The written test shall have two parts, each having twenty multiple choice questions to be answered in thirty minutes. Part - A shall be on Basics of Planning / Basics of Architecture. A candidate who has applied for both Planning and Architecture related programmes shall have to appear for the written paper on both Basics of Planning as well as Basics of Architecture which will be conducted back to back.
5. Once the written examination on Basics of Planning / Basics of Architecture is completed, a candidate shall be required to write Part - B of the examination which will be based on the Basics of the Specialisation (Programme wise) s/he has applied for.
6. Such written examination for each Specialisation (Programme wise) would be conducted back to back in such a way that a candidate who has applied for more than one programme can sit for all the Specialisation wise written tests smoothly.
7. Before the commencement of the Written Examination, candidate shall write a brief write up within 150 words on his / her choice for a particular programme or his/her expectation from the particular programme or his/her decision to pursue masters within the given space provided for and within the given time.
8. A student shall not carry any mobile phone, calculator or any other instrument, tools and gadgets inside the examination hall. Any candidate found possessing any such item shall be summarily expelled from the examination hall.
9. Unfair means shall be sternly dealt with. A candidate resorting to unfair means shall be summarily expelled from the examination hall.
10. A candidate must take their respective seat inside the examination hall ten minutes before the commencement of the examination. No student will be allowed to leave the examination hall till the end of respective part of the written examinations.
