# Riparian Restoration Training Program and Plantation Activity on Kolans River

The Kolans River, a feeder river for Bhoj wetland in Bhopal Serves significant ecological functions. Over the years, agricultural activities, pollution, and habitat degradation have weakened its ecological function, particularly along the riparian zones. These edge areas, critical for filtering runoff, preventing erosion, and providing habitat, have witnessed loss of vegetation and awareness. Reviving the riparian ecology requires participatory approaches, combining community-based training with ecological restoration through plantations. This proposal outlines a program for riparian training and afforestation along priority sections of the Kolans River.
